This is a skin for HP 48 Emu - A Hewlett Packard scientific calculators emulator:

HP 48GX Photorealistic 24 bit High Res Skin - Version 1.0 - By Angel David Guzmán - PixelOz

This skin is based on Jemac's - Jeffery L. McMahan original skin scripts and it also uses a modified photographic image from the HP calculators emulators archive web site (web address given below).

You can download the HP calculator emulator Emu 48 from the following location:

Remember that for the program to work you have to add the calculator rom files that you can download from the same web site. You have to create a ROM directory inside the directory where the program is installed where you will place the ROM images. The ROM images available in this web site need to be converted using the converter.exe utility included with the program. Look for this utility in the same directory where you installed the emulator and instructions on how to use this utility are also in the same directory in a file named EMU48.TXT. Once they have been converted to the proper format (the final name should be something like ROM.48G for example) they should be placed in that directory. For this particular skin you need a HP 48GX ROM file which should have a final name of ROM.48G cause it is the same name I have in the .KML script file for it. There are several HP 48 GX ROM files in the hpcalc.org web site, you can find them in 5 versions (Revisions K,M,L,P and R) and you can use any of those, the R revision was the latest.

To use this skin just unzip everything contained in this zip file and place all in the same directory where the program is installed. Also you have to take the file named DavidHP48GX-24bit1.KML (that I include in this zip file) and load it in the Windows Notepad program and modify the ROM line to reflect the location of your ROM files. This is specifically the fifth line from the top that says:

Rom "ROM.48G"

If you created a ROM directory inside the directory where Emu 48 is installed as I instructed previously the line should be modified as follows for example:

Rom "ROM/ROM.48G"

Now save the text file making sure that it retains the .KML extension in the name.

Now when you start the program you will see a pop-up window titled **Choose Your KML Script** and in the drop down box in that window titled **Current KML Script** choose **David's 24 bit Gx** to use my skin then click the **OK** button and then in the window that appears click the **OK** button too and enjoy!
