

Programs and installation

The file COMPMARA of the archive COMPMARA.ZIP is an HP49G directory that contains all programs of the marathon. If you transfer this file to your HP49G, then use XMODEM. A new directory will be created on the HP49G, with the name COMPMARA, in which you will find the programs.

The folder PROGRAMS_TXT of the archive COMPMARA.ZIP contains all programs of the marathon as text files. You can transfer them to the HP49G using Kermit, but they are thought for editing rather, than for transferring. If you would like to change some program, then you can do that on your Mac/PC using your favourite text editor and a real keyboard, and then transfer the program to your HP49G. The programs in this folder can be transferred to the HP49G, but you must rename them on your HP49G, when the transfer is done. The table below shows all programs that have to be renamed.
